THE ROAD TO THE CLASSIC

- Rising through the ranks of the B.A.S.S. Federation Nation to compete in bass fishing's most prestigious tournament takes dedication and perseverance, but the rewards for advancing to the next level are great. The steps from local club to Classic are presented below:
- CLUBS & STATE TEAMS: Anglers qualify through their local clubs for the State Team Qualifier Tournaments. The State Chapters of the B.A.S.S. Federation Nation hold State Team Qualifier(s) to qualify a 20-person team. States determine the qualifier format for their state. Lat qualifier must be in a pro/am format.
- <u>DIVISIONALS</u>: B.A.S.S. invites each B.A.S.S. Federation Nation state chapter to bring a 20-person team to one of 3 (three) B.A.S.S. Federation Nation Divisional tournaments. The format of the divisional is determined by B.A.S.S. The purpose of the divisional is to qualify the top boater and top non-boater from each state for the B.A.S.S. Federation Nation Championship.
- FEDERATION NATION CHAMPIONSHIP: Currently 48 B.A.S.S. State Federation Nations and eight B.A.S.S. International Federation Nations compete within one of the 3 (three) divisions to qualify for the Bassmaster Classic. The anglers compete individually in this tournament to determine a champion, however, the highest three finishing anglers will earn a berth into the Bassmaster Classic.

State Team – consists of 20 members now

How do we qualify our State Team members?

- Currently we have a Qualifier in the East and a Qualifier in the West and a PRO-am Qualifier.
- Any member can fish either/or/all events to try and qualify.
- Must pay entry fee for each event fished.
- Top seven advance to the State Team from the Eastern Qualifier and the top seven from the Western Qualifier and Top 3 boaters and top three non-boaters advance from Pro-am

East and West State Tournaments

- Cost \$400 per club to enter 6 man team
 Can send as many members as you want, must be in increments of 2 for boater/non-boater pairings. Cost if not full 6 man team is \$80 each
- 3. \$30 Extra If no worker provided
- 4. \$10 for big fish (optional)

Payout for the State Tournaments:

- Payout to number 1 team \$500
- There is a optional side pot, \$30, \$100% paid to top 10% of field.
- Note that individuals can also qualify for Triton/Mercury Owner and Skeeter Real Dollars, etc. as well

How does your club join and what are the cost??

- Must be a member of B.A.S.S. Always check or call when you renew your membership. They offer specials all the time. Annual membership is \$25 unless you catch a special offer. \$15 annual membership deals are pretty common.
- 2. <u>Club Dues NC BASS Federation Nation</u> \$15 per member
- 3. Club Dues for B.A.S.S. Federation Nation Each club will pay \$30 per member. In November of each year, Bass will send the Club secretary a rebate check if they qualifiy: Clubs with 13-20 members will receive a \$3 per member rebate in November Clubs with over 20 members will receive a rebate check of \$5 per member.
- 4. Example A club has 21 members will receive a check in November for \$105.

I have received most of the surveys and would like to propose this method for qualifying for the 2017 state team:

- 1. Western Qualifier Top Boater and Top Non-Boater automatically qualify for 2017 state team Top 5 advance regardless of boater/non-boater status
- 2. Eastern Qualifier Top Boater and Top Non-Boater automatically qualify for 2017 state team Top 5 advance regardless of boater/non-boater status
- 3. Third Qualifier Location to be drawn from the approved list of locations that are in the rotation.

 Top two Boaters and Top Two Non-Boaters automatically qualify for 2017 state team
- 4. Points Top two Boaters and Top two Non-boaters in <u>points</u> from the three events to encourage participation in all three events.

So we will qualify 6 from the west qualifier. 6 from the eastern qualifier, 4 from the Third qualifier, and 4 from points for a total of 20.

All tourneys will be in the <u>Pro-Am format</u>. <u>Payouts</u> will be based on the Pro-Am format (Boaters vs. Boaters and Non-Boaters vs. Non-Boaters).

Each club will be able to vote on this proposal via email or at the annual meeting. Final decision will be decided by March 1st, 2016. No votes will be counted for clubs voting that have not paid their dues by March 1st.

If for some reason this method is turned down by the clubs, we will use the same format as we used in 2015 to qualify the 2016 State Team. (No big deal)

Take this back to your clubs and let me know if your club votes to <u>approve the proposal or not</u>. This is a little different than last year but this has been put together based on the responses to the surveys received. Remember, for every six members, your club has one vote, so if you have 24 members, it counts as 4 votes. We need to find a way to increase participation and I think the point system will help increase that some.






